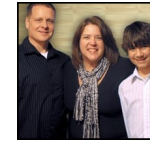

***KENYA**— Christian 82.6%; Muslim 8.3%
Pressing challenges for Kenya include high unemployment and poverty. Despite a declining infection rate, 500 people still die of AIDS every day in the country. Kenyans, by law, have freedom of religion. Nearly 50% identify themselves as evangelical Christians. The coast and northwest areas of the country have traditionally been Muslim. Muslims try to convert non-Muslims through financial inducements and violence.
