

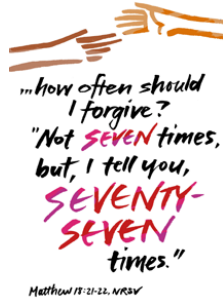

AROUND THE WORLD

Bhutan - 2.11% Christians; 1.8% Evangelicals; 74.56% Buddhist
Christians in Bhutan are viewed and treated as traitors to the country's particular brand of nationalism. The government is intent on maintaining a strong national identity and unity by suppressing "foreign" elements, including Christianity. According to the government, the definition of Bhutanese identity is Buddhism, and it works to eliminate groups perceived as threats. Ethnic religious beliefs have merged with the Buddhist identity, further ostracizing Christians, especially in the central and eastern parts of the country. Pray God will strengthen believers who violate anti-conversion law by leaving the Buddhist faith.

AFRICAN WATER PROJECT: TBC will be raising funds for the Orisai Village in Africa where drought is a common problem and the people suffer needlessly from a lack of access to clean water and proper sanitation. Our goal is to raise \$22,000 and we have a match of \$10,000. **TODAY** is our deadline, although funds will still be accepted. To date, we have collected **\$6,660** - Praise Be to God!
