Deuteronomy 18:15, 18; etc. (Advent Roles #1)

◆ Moses' promise

The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own brothers. You must listen to him. . . The LORD said to me . . . , "I will raise up a prophet like you from among their brothers; I will put my words in his mouth, and he will tell them everything I command him."

Deuteronomy 18:15, 18

◆ Peoples' perception

"We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." John 1:45 (cf. 6:14; 7:40; Acts 3:22; 7:37)

They were all filled with awe and praised God. "A great prophet has appeared among us," they said. "God has come to help his people." Luke 7:16 (cf. 7:39; 24:19-21)

◆ Jesus' practice

"I tell you the truth. No prophet is accepted in his hometown." Luke 4:24 (cf. 13:33; Matthew 10:40-42; 13:57; Mark 6:4; John 4:44; Acts 7:52)

"The one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit. The Father loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands." John 3:34-35 (cf. 5:24; 14:10, 24)

"I gave them the words you gave me. . . I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world." John 17:8, 14

Mark Jones - Living Church, Ohio

Around the World

***DJIBOUTI** - 97% Muslim; 1.75% Christian

The government officially recognizes three Christian groups (French Protestant, Roman Catholic and Ethiopian Orthodox). Although proselytism is not illegal, it is discouraged. Foreigners have considerable religious freedom, but citizens who even express an interest in converting to Christianity face the risk of persecution. Converts are often isolated; their families may ostracize, beat or even kill them for deserting Islam. In some areas of the capital city it is forbidden to practice any religion other than Islam, while in other areas inhabitants are free to practice any religion.
