HUNTING SEASON

Proverbs 6:20-7:27 (Real Life #7)

Memory verses: *Now then, my sons, listen to me; pay attention to what I say. Do not let your heart turn to her ways or stray into her paths.*

Proverbs 7:24-25 (cf. 4:23)

- ◆ If you are considering breaking the rules, consider the cost. (6:24-35)
- ◆ Wise up about where you go and where it leads. (7:6-23, 26-27)

Many are the victims (the casualties) she has brought down; her slain are a mighty throng. Her house is a highway to the grave (literally, the way to Sheol), leading down to the chambers of death. 7:26-27

- ◆ Guard yourself (and get a one-time license). (6:20-24; 7:1-5, 26-27)

“For from within, out of men’s hearts come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. All these evils come from inside a make a man ‘unclean.’” Mark 7:21-23 (cf. Proverbs 4:23; 7:24-25; Revelation 2:23; Luke 16:15; Ezekiel 36:26)

If you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 10:9 (cf. Ephesians 3:17)

NEXT STEPS: Read through the text each day this week. Before you do, begin with a prayer asking God to speak to you through it. Review the outline and other scriptures. Share with another where God seems to be stirring. How are you practicing “hunter safety?” Is there another of the same gender whom God is asking you to encourage? Pray for each other, thanking God that He “went hunting” for you (Luke 19:10).

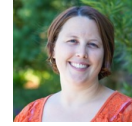

***COMOROS** - 98.8% Muslim; 0.9% Christian

Christians often face persecution from both the community and their own families. Those of Comorian ethnicity face the greatest opposition. Fewer than 6,500 Christian nationals are part of this country of 770,000. Only noncitizens may attend the two Catholic churches and one Protestant church in the country; no official churches exist for the Comorian people. Local authorities impose additional restrictions on the practice of Christianity in some areas.
