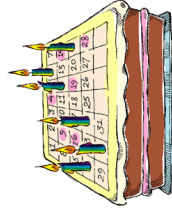

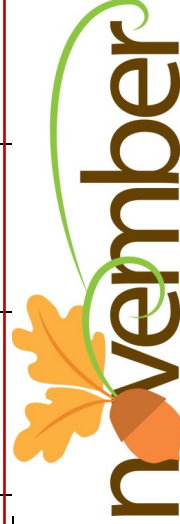

**50 years of ministry include the people whom God has raised up through the TBC family to join Him on mission around the world.**

**Who comes to your mind ... women and men impacted by the Good News of Jesus, equipped for service in His Kingdom?**

Perhaps you think of former staff members who went on to serve as pastors and trainers of other pastors: Virgil Schmidt, Doug Bittle, Bryan Hochhalter, Kimlyn Bender, Kerry Bender, Kelvin Friesen.

Perhaps you think of the *homegrown* ones like Chris Hoke (former youth director), Mark Jaspers (worship and youth pastor), Mike Jaspers (director of media), Chris Kramlich (missionary), Kalen Heller (preparing to be a chaplain) Kathleen Heller (retired chaplain) or Jeri Lynch (seminary student preparing for service in Christian counseling).

Or maybe you think of TBC member Debbie Kitchel (executive director of Christian Mission Aid) or Ryan Jensen (Bridges International).

Consider, also, the TBC students who have attended Bible colleges and seminaries in places like Edmonton, Denver, Sioux Falls, St. Paul, etc.

Or perhaps you think of those who've served on summer projects with CRU (Campus Crusade), Child Evangelism Fellowship or Crystal Springs Camp. **TBC people have served and continue to serve across the country and around the world.**

Think of the mission trips to places like Cannon Ball, Winnipeg, Mexico, Russia and Africa. Don't forget the ministries through the local jail, prison, state hospital and college.

TBC will be sending a team of six (Erin and Pat Motschenbacher, Doris and Dean Giedt, Kristy and Randy Jaspers) in January – February to partner with Debbie

Kitchel and other Christian Mission Aid folks to train teachers and pastors in the rural areas of Uganda, as well as visiting other CMA works in Kenya. This is part of the global impact of TBC. **(You can be part of this mission through the Hog Roast and Silent Auction November 2.)**

**But mission is not always going to another part of the world. It is living each day with a mission mindset wherever our Lord places us . . . in our job, our neighborhood, our school, our home . . . beginning here. We recognize that God is a God of and on mission all around us, in us and through us. He calls us to be people joining Him on mission, living as His missionaries, giving witness through our lives and our words to Jesus, the One Who Gives (and Is) Life.**
