EVERYDAY EVANGELISM: THE LIFE WE SPEAK

1 Peter 3:15-16 (Everyday Church #6)

When you and I live in God's grace together, the world sees . . .

- ◆ An unanticipated submission.

So then, those who suffer according to God's will should commit themselves to their faithful Creator and continue to do good.

1 Peter 4:19 (cf. 2:19-25; 3:14, 17-18; 4:1, 15-16)

- ◆ An unblamable character.

As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace. 1 Peter 4:10 (ESV; cf. 4:1-4)

- ◆ An uncompromising love.

Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.

1 Peter 4:8 (cf. 5:14; 1:8; 22-23; 2:11; 3:8; 4:12; 2:17)

We love because he first loved us. 1 John 4:19

- ◆ An undying hope.

Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God. 1 Peter 1:21 (cf. 1:3, 13; 3:5)

- ◆ An unexpected Savior.

Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up into your salvation, now that you have tasted that the Lord is good.

1 Peter 2:2-3 (cf. 1:5, 9-10)

NEXT STEPS: Review the outline and scripture. Ask another person if/how she sees these things in you. To what extent are you trying to do this solo? Discuss the benefits of being and living as a good-news community. What hesitations do you have? What is God directing for you now? *Lord, as You give Your power, You also will give the courage to live in Your grace in*
