Indonesia - 15.85% Christians; 5.6% Evangelicals; 80.31% Muslim
Political, cultural and religious forces all contribute to the persecution of Christians in Indonesia. Conservative Muslim political parties and radical Islamic groups exert great influence, resulting in Sharia-inspired policies and public opinion that opposes Christianity. These groups can mobilize hundreds of thousands of people. While the government tightens the country's blasphemy laws, most problems for believers occur in local confrontations with radical Islamic groups.

Rick and Debbie serve at Mbingo Baptist Hospital in Bamenda, Cameroon. Rick is a board-certified medical doctor in Internal Medicine and Pathology, and Debbie is a staff nurse. The last couple of months have been busy for them. Debbie spent a month in North America, most of the time with family; due to lack of pathology coverage, Rick was only able to get away for two weeks. Part of their time away was spent at Triennial, which was a great time of reunion and renewal. Continue to pray for the ongoing unrest in Cameroon, specifically that Mbingo Baptist Hospital would continue to be a neutral zone amidst the unrest. Pray as well that political unrest would not hinder the volunteer doctors from returning to the training programs.
