## THE ALLURE OF ANOTHER

Proverbs 5:1-23 (*Real Life #5*)

Memory verse: *For a man's ways are in full view of the LORD, and he examines all his paths.* Proverbs 5:21

- ◆ Pay attention to (your father's) wisdom, not the flattery of "the other woman". (vss. 1-6)
- ◆ Purposely avoid certain paths (or, Choose your way wisely). (vss. 7-14)
- ◆ Physical passion belongs in your marriage. Enjoy each other. (vss. 15-19)

*The man and his wife were both naked, and they felt no shame.* Genesis 2:28

*Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.* Hebrews 13:4

- ◆ Practice living in God's sight, rather than stumbling into sin's grasp. (vss. 20-23)

**NEXT STEPS:** Read through Proverbs 5 several times, stopping to meditate on a word or phrase that gets your attention. Review the outline. Take turns praising God for one thing. Share a prayer request and pray together. Conclude by reading Hebrews 4:12-16 aloud.

**\*CHIAPAS (Mexico)** - 64.5% Folk Catholicism; 21.9% Christian Catholicism is heavily blended with traditions from indigenous religions. Evangelicals face prejudice, harassment, expulsion from villages, attacks against their churches and private property, threats of sexual assault, imprisonment and murder. Opposition to evangelicals comes mostly from their refusal to participate in syncretistic community religious events involving pagan rituals and heavy drinking.
