FOUR LIFE LESSONS

Proverbs 6:1-19 (Real Life #6)

There are six things the LORD hates, seven that are detestable to him.

Proverbs 6:16

- ◆ Hasty words can lead to long-term liabilities. Beware of entanglement. (vss. 1-5; cf. 11:15; 17:18; 20:16; 22:26-17; 27:13)

"Give me, O God, the pledge you demand. Who else will put up security for me?" Job 17:3

Jesus Christ, the Righteous One, is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for those of the whole world. 1 John 2:1-2

- ◆ Where does laziness lead? Beware of entitlement. (vss. 6-11; cf. 10:26; 13:4; 15:19; 19:24; 20:4; 22:13; 24:30-34; 26:13-16)
- ◆ Conspirators will ultimately destroy themselves. Beware of entrapment. (vss. 12-15; cf. 19:28; Judges 20:13; 1 Samuel 10:27; 2 Samuel 20:1; 2 Chronicles 13:7)
- ◆ Seven things the LORD hates/detestes. Be people of entrustment. (vss. 16-19)

"For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Mark 10:45, cf. Matthew 20:25-28; Luke 22:24-30

NEXT STEPS: Read Proverbs 6:1-19 several times and memorize 6:16 (Bonus: memorize 6:16-19). Review the outline and reflect on which lesson is most important for you now. Share with another what you are learning, where you are being challenged and how he/she can pray for you. Conclude with a time of praise to God.
