(One Another #3)

- ◆ Speak truthfully as truthfully as members of one another.

*Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.* Ephesians 4:25

- ◆ Instruct with God's word, not your own opinion.

*I myself am satisfied about you, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able to instruct one another.* Romans 15:14

*Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness (grace) in your hearts to God.* Colossians 3:16

## AROUND THE WORLD

**Vietnam** - 55.9% Buddhism; 9.5% Christianity  
Vietnam is a one-party Communist state. The government controls all religious activities. Religious organizations are required to register, and Christians and the church face land confiscations. In particular, minority groups face government harassment. Pastors and churches are subject to arrest, interrogation, and beatings. Local authorities in rural areas target new believers for especially harsh treatment, including village expulsion.
