THE WISDOM PROTECTION PROGRAM

Proverbs 2:1-22 (*Real Life #2*)

Memory verses: *Wisdom will save you from the ways of wicked men . . . It will save you also from the adulteress.* Proverbs 2:12a, 16a

Three *ifs* (vss. 1-2, 3, 4) and two *thens* (vss. 5-8; 9-11)

- ◆ Wisdom leads us to a better path: faithfulness to the straight path. (2:12-15)
- ◆ Wisdom leads us to a better plan: faithfulness to our spouse. (2:16-19)

The wise woman builds her house, but with her own hands the foolish one tears hers down. Proverbs 14:1

So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall! No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it. 1 Corinthians 10:12-13 (cf. Hebrews 4:12-16)

NEXT STEPS: Read through Proverbs 2 twice. Review the three *ifs* (vss. 1-2, 3, 4) and the two *thens* (vss. 5-8 & 9-11). Share with another how you have encountered the two temptations (vss. 12-15 & 16-19). How are you dealing with them? What have you learned about sin? About how to resist it? Review the outline and verses. Is there someone with whom you can share your experience, to help them avoid what they do not see ahead? Talk together how you could do this. Recite the memory verses. Share one request and one praise each. Pray together.

***BHUTAN** - 74.6% Buddhist; 2.1% Christian

Christians (3,000-6,000) may practice their faith in private, but public worship and evangelism are limited. Non-Buddhist houses of worship and meetings are forbidden. The National Security Act prohibits proselytism or incitement to convert. (Converts face loss of citizenship.) Christians are denied state benefits (free education, access to electricity and water, health care and employment).
