## REAL LOVE

Matthew 22:34-40 (YIConnect #1)

*Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: "Love your neighbor as yourself." All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matthew 22:37-40*

Real love is tied to relationship .

*God is love. Whoever abides in love abides in God, and God in him. 1 John 4:16b*

*This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. 1 John 4:10*

Real love is centered in real life.

*We love because he first loved us. If anyone says, "I love God," yet hates his brother, he is a liar. For anyone who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen. And he has given us this command: Whoever loves God must also love his brother. 1 John 4:19-21*

Real love is lived in real time.

*"Which of these three do you think was neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?" The expert in the law replied, "The one who had mercy on him." Jesus told him, "Go and do likewise." Luke 10:36-37*

Real love holds two hands.

*Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. 1 John 4:11*

\***INDIA** - Hindu 74.3%; Christian 5.8%

The Indian constitution guarantees freedom of religion. Yet 6 of the 29 state governments have laws forbidding "forcible conversions". These laws, which are frequently used against Christians, make it illegal to convert someone "by force, fraud, or allurement." Violence against Christians continues in the form of Bible burnings, destruction of churches and other property, imprisonments, beatings and murders. Attackers are rarely charged.
