Connecting with God and You

To **WORSHIP** God, help people to **KNOW** Jesus Christ personally, **GROW** to be like Him, **SHOW** His love, and **GO** where He leads . . . **TOGETHER.**



How does a person live in a world that is increasingly ambivalent or even hostile to those who identify with the church? What would God have us do?

God's word already addresses this issue. The book of 1 Peter is written to followers of Jesus who live in such a world. Peter reminds his readers that God is already at work, beginning in them . . . and through them to impact those who do not know Him.

Being a follower of Jesus is not just about Sunday morning . . . it's about the other 6½ days as well, perhaps more so. Beginning September 8 we will spend 8 weeks **discovering and practicing how to live each day, every day, with Jesus for Jesus.** How do we live each day, every day on mission with Him?

Five Resources: (The more ways you participate, the more opportunities you have to grow and join God in His work.)

- ***Messages** each week from 1 Peter.
- ***Personal study materials** are available to help us dig deeper and live out what we are learning daily.
- ***Small groups** are the place where we interact, encourage each other and practice what we are learning together. Watch for sign-up details.
